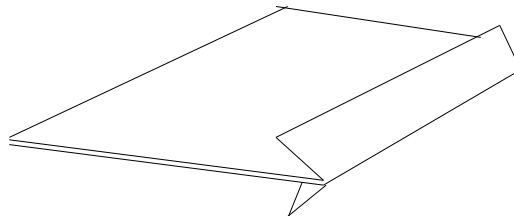
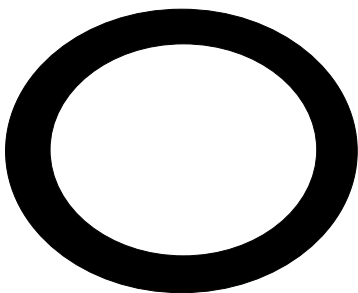
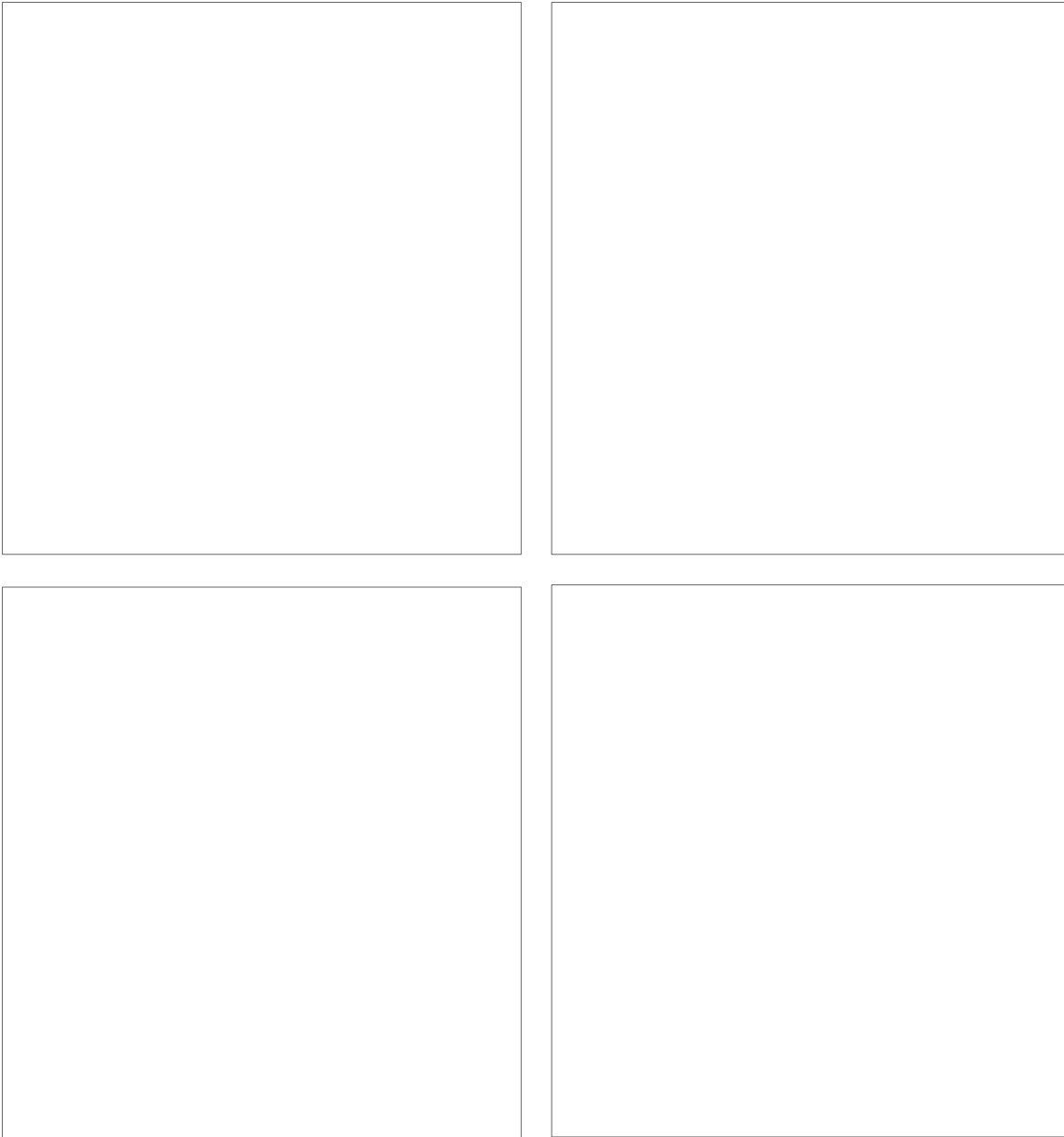


* Cut out and fold tan rectangles along dotted lines, tan sides out. Glue shut. Repeat with second tan rectangle. These are the scrapbook covers.

*Cut out brown rectangles and fold lengthwise along line. Glue around long raw edge of cover. (see illustration at left) Repeat with second cover. These are the bindings.

- * Cut out inner sheets for scrapbook. Poke holes in the 3 dots on the marked cover.
- * Place one sheet at a time under the pierced cover to align and mark where the holes go in the inner sheets so they will thread together like a school binder. Lastly, mark the back cover.
- * Thread a piece of twine through the front cover, inner pages, and back cover and loosely tie at the spine of your scrapbook.
- * Cut out the “Memories” square, the brown square, and the black oval. Clip away the white center of both the black oval and the brown square.
- * Place a wide shiny piece of sticky tape over the part that says “Memories”. This will mimic a protective glass plate. Apply a thin layer of tacky glue to the back and place it in the center of scrapbook front cover. Now glue the brown square atop and centered with the text. Glue the black oval centered with the cut out oval.
- * Shrink favorite photos on the scanner (glossy photo paper). Print and paste them in the scrapbook.
